# BEN REED

Bringing life experiences to work

INTERVIEW: ROBERT PIPER

RP: WHAT INSPIRES YOU IN LIFE?

BR: My family, opportunities. I love what I do. I love work, so to get to do what I love to do and what I'm passionate about—plus raise my family—is very inspiring to me. I have five kids and there's never a dull moment. They're opening me up to a new world every day.

RP: HOW DO YOU STAY HEALTHY?

BR: I have a little workout regimen. Every morning, I go to the gym around five thirty. I also am a cyclist. I play pickup basketball. Stuff like that.

RP: HOW DID YOU START ACTING?

BR: I graduated from college, from Oklahoma, jumped in my car, drove twenty-three hours, and went and did a summer session at the American Academy of Dramatic Arts. Never got to do any theater or anything in the high school growing up or in college, because I was an athlete. I played quarterback for West Virginia University, so that was like a full-time job. When I figured out I wasn't going to go pro because of injuries, I decided to go do what I wanted to do, and that was be an actor. I dove out here and jumped in with both feet.

RP: WHAT TYPE OF RESEARCH GOES INTO PREPARING FOR A ROLE?

BR: Let's look at *American Sniper*, playing a father of a young man that I'm trying to mold into a model citizen. Since I have five kids, I had a lot to draw from. Also, looking at that as a father of a soldier. My brother's in Special Forces. I wanted to talk to Chris Kyle's father [the movie is based on Chris's autobiography of the same title], but that opportunity didn't arise. I called my father. It was kind of cool because I never really sit and ask him questions about what it's like to send your son into the armed forces, knowing that there's an opportunity for him to get shot. It was great listening to him, and then I also talked to my brother about what his thoughts were when he was getting ready to crash into a home to see if there were any insurgents or anything in there. All that type of research and then just drawing from my own life. They did a really nice job writing, and Clint Eastwood did a great job with the film.
